

# Biography of ROBERT LEWANDOWSKI

## Youth

He was born in 1988 in Warsaw, Poland. Robert grew up in a sports family – his mother played volleyball and his father trained judo. When Robert was 8 years old, he started playing in his first football club – Varsovia. He was very good in school and on the football pitch. In 2006, when Robert was 17, his father died.



## Beginning of a professional career

When Robert was 17 years old, he started to play in professional football clubs – Legia Warszawa and then in Znicz Pruszków. In 2008 he moved to big Polish club – Lech Poznań. Robert played there two years and he scored 41 goals in 82 matches. In this club Lewandowski started to be famous in Poland and Europe.

## Famous Career

In 2010 Robert came to famous German club – Borussia Dortmund where he became a star scoring a total of 10 goals in 187 matches. Thanks to him Borussia won many tournaments.

In 2014 he was bought to the best German club – Bayern Munich where he has played to this day. Together with this club Robert won the most important awards in Germany as well as at European and world stadiums.



## Family

Robert has been married to Anna Stachurska since 2013. They have two children - Klara and Laura. Robert spends every free time with his family. They live in Poland and in Germany.



## Career in Polish national team

Robert has been playing for the Polish national team since 2008 and in 2014 he became the captain. Robert Lewandowski plays as a center forward. Robert has scored for the national team 63 goals in 116 matches. Together with national team he was promoted twice to the European Championship and once to the World Championship.



## Charity activities

Robert and his wife support many charities giving their money, for example, to help sick children or to fight the coronavirus.



In 2016 Lewandowski scored 5 goals in 9 minutes in league match. This event was recorded in the Guinness World Record. In 2020 Robert won Champions League and he won the award – UEFA Men's Player of the Year and he became the best footballer in the world.
